

## Terms used on your TenneT TSO B.V. invoice

<b>Invoice date</b>	The (approximate) date on which TenneT generated the invoice.
<b>Customer number</b>	Your accounts receivable number at TenneT.
<b>Invoice number</b>	A unique number used to identify your invoice. If you contact us with a question about your invoice, we will ask you to provide this number.
<b>VAT number</b>	Your VAT number, which we state on your invoice at your request.
<b>Our reference</b>	Our reference, which is stated on your invoice for administrative purposes.
<b>Your reference</b>	Your reference, which is stated on your invoice at your request.

<b>Standing charge for transmission services*</b>	This charge covers the fixed costs of transmission (i.e. those costs that are independent of the quantities being transmitted). This includes the costs associated with processing metering data and managing the register of connections, as well as the billing costs. The tariff depends on the voltage level of your connection. <b>These costs are billed over the current month.</b>
<b>Recurring connection fee</b>	The recurring connection fee covers the costs of managing and maintaining your connection. The fee is charged per connection, and consists of a fixed charge which is set annually. <b>These costs are billed over the current month.</b>
<b>Connection fee for additional length</b>	The connection fee for additional length covers the cost of managing and maintaining your connection if it is longer than 25 metres. The fee consists of a fixed charge which is set annually. <b>These costs are billed over the current month.</b>
<b>Meter rental</b>	This item concerns the amount you owe to TenneT for the use of your electricity meter. <b>These costs are billed over the current month.</b>
<b>Metering service</b>	This item is included in your invoice if you have agreed with TenneT that we also provide the metering service for your connection. <b>These costs are billed over the current month.</b>
<b>kW contracted*</b>	This tariff component covers 50% of the transmission-related costs, including operating costs, the costs of constructing and maintaining the grid infrastructure, and the costs of purchasing energy to cover grid losses. The 'kW contracted' tariff component concerns the maximum capacity you reasonably expect to require for your connection at any given moment in the year, expressed in kilowatts (kW). If this maximum value is exceeded, the tariff is adjusted accordingly. The tariff depends on the use you make of the transmission grid, expressed in hours (either 600 hours or less, or more than 600 hours). <b>These costs are billed over the current month.</b>

<b>Exceedance of 'kW contracted' tariff component</b>	If your usage in the past month has exceeded the contracted maximum value, we will charge you for the difference between the exceedance and the applicable contracted value, with retroactive effect to 1 January of the current year or with retroactive effect to the date during the year on which you changed your contracted value.
<b>kW max*</b>	The 'kW max' tariff component serves to cover the other 50% of the transmission-related costs (also see 'kW contracted'). This tariff component concerns the actual maximum load caused by your company on your connection during the usage period. The tariff depends on the use you make of the transmission grid, expressed in hours (either 600 hours or less, or more than 600 hours). <b>These costs are billed over the <u>past</u> month.</b>
<b>System services*</b>	System services are the activities performed by TenneT to guarantee the safe and efficient transmission of electricity across its grids, and to maintain or restore the energy balance between supply and demand on all electricity grids in the Netherlands. <b>The costs of these services are billed over the <u>past</u> month based on a fixed rate per kilowatt-hour (kWh).</b>
